DAY 1 | NARITA / HANEDA ARRIVAL - TOKYO

Arrive at Narita / Haneda Airport (Tokyo). You will be greeted by your English-speaking guide and taken directly to your hotel by private bus. After arriving at the hotel, enjoy your free time.

- **Accommodation:** Sunshine City Prince Hotel (or similar)
- **What's included:** Tour Guide, Private bus



DAY 2 | TOKYO

Start a full day sightseeing tour in Tokyo by public transportation. Tokyo Sky Tree (up to Tembo Deck at 350m), the Nakamise Shopping Arcade, the stately Asakusa Kannon Temple and Free at leisure.

- **Accommodation:** Sunshine City Prince Hotel (or similar)
- **What's included:** Breakfast, Dinner, Tour Guide, Private bus, admission fee



DAY 3 | BLENDING INTO THE LOCAL TOKYO

Start a full day sightseeing tour in Tokyo by public transportation. The Imperial Palace Plaza, Meiji Shrine, Harajuku District (Takeshita Street), Shibuya Crossing.

DAY 4 | TOKYO - NIKKO - TOKYO

Start a full-day sightseeing tour in Nikko by chartered coach. Shinkyo Bridge (outside ONLY), Nikko Toshogu Shrine, Rinno-ji Temple (Taiyu-in), Futarasan Shrine.

- **Accommodation:** Sunshine City Prince Hotel (or similar)
- **What's included:** Breakfast, Lunch, Tour Guide, Private bus, admission fee



DAY 5 | TOKYO - HAKONE - YUGAWARA

Start a full-day sightseeing tour in Hakone by chartered coach. Hakone Ropeway, Owakudani Boiling Valley, Lake Ashi Boat Cruise, Old Tokaido road. After sightseeing, proceed to Yugawara by chartered coach.

- **Accommodation:** Oyado Zuiyo (or similar)
- **What's included:** Breakfast, Dinner, Tour Guide, Private bus, admission fee, Baggage transfer



DAY 6 | YUGAWARA - ATAMI - TAKAYAMA

Transfer to Atami Station by chartered coach. Transfer to Nagoya Station by Super Express Shinkansen. Arrive at Nagoya Station and change trains. Arrive at Takayama Station and transfer to the hotel by public transportation or on foot. Free at leisure until dinner.

- **Accommodation:** Hotel and Spa Gift Takayama (or similar)
- **What's included:** Breakfast, Dinner, Tour Guide, Private bus, Train ticket, public transportation

DAY 7 | TAKAYAMA

Start a full-day sightseeing tour in Takayama by public transportation. Sanmachi Street, Miyagawa Morning Market, Yatai Kaikan (Festival Float Museum) Free time to walk the old street on your own Funasaka Sake Brewery (Tasting Sake in the shops), Takayama Jinya (Historical Government Office).

- **Accommodation:** Hotel and Spa Gift Takayama (or similar)
- **What's included:** Breakfast, Dinner, Tour Guide, public transportation



DAY 8 | TAKAYAMA - SHIRAKAWAGO - KANAZAWA

Start a full-day sightseeing tour in Shirakawago Village and Kanazawa by chartered coach.

Shirakawago Village, Kanda House

Proceed to Kanazawa by chartered coach.

Higashi-chaya District, Kenroku-en Garden.

- **Accommodation:** Kanazawa New Grand Hotel Prestige (or similar)

DAY 9 | KANAZAWA - KYOTO

Transfer to Kanazawa Station by public transportation.

Arrive at Kanazawa Station.

Transfer to Tsuruga Station by Super Express Shinkansen.

Transfer to Kyoto Station by express train. Sightseeing tour in Kyoto by chartered coach. Arashiyama Area with Bamboo Grove, Kinkaku-ji Temple.

- **Accommodation:** ALA Hotel Kyoto (or similar)
- **What's included:** Breakfast, Dinner, public transportation, Train ticket, admission fee, Baggage transfer



DAY 10 | KYOTO

Start a full-day sightseeing tour in Kyoto by chartered coach.

Kiyomizu Temple, Ninenzaka & Sannenzaka Slopes, Walk through Higashiyama to Gion, Nanzenji Temple, Philosopher's Walk, Ginkaku-ji Temple.

Leave Kyoto for Hiroshima by Super Express Shinkansen. Arrive at Hiroshima Station, Transfer to Miyajima Island by ferry. Itsukushima Shrine, Miyajimaguchi for Miyajima Island by ferry. Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum, Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park and A-Bomb Dome.

- **Accommodation:** Hiroshima Grand Intelligent Hotel (or similar)
- **What's included:** Breakfast, Dinner, Tour Guide, Private bus, Train ticket, admission fee, Baggage transfer



DAY 13 | HIROSHIMA - HIMEJI - OSAKA

Leave Hiroshima for Himeji by Super Express Shinkansen. Start a full-day sightseeing tour in Himeji by chartered coach. Himeji Castle & Koko-en Garden. Proceed to Hotel in Osaka by chartered coach.

- **Accommodation:** Miyako City Osaka Honmachi (or similar)
- **What's included:** Breakfast, Dinner, Tour Guide, Private bus, Train ticket, admission fee



DAY 14 | OSAKA- KANSAI AIRPORT - KANSAI DEPARTURE

Free at leisure until departure.

Transfer to Kansai International Airport by chartered coach.

Arrive at Kansai International Airport. Leave Japan by flight xx-xxx.

- **What's included:** Breakfast, Tour Guide, Private bus
